These began before the Declaration of the State of Israel

COUNCIL'S EARLY PROJECTS IN PALESTINE

- Yemenite Infant Welfare Centre in Tel Aviv (1923)
- Ezra was adopted by NCJW during the 1920's
- Children's Clinic in Jerusalem (1923)
- Maternity Ward at Misgav Ladach Hospital (1928)
- Dormitory at Australia House, Hebrew University
- Hadassah Hospital, 10 bed ward in Gynaecological Department (1937)
- NCJW Queen Competition raised funds for JNF from 1939, including during the war years until the 1980s
- During the 1940s trees were planted in the NCJW JNF Grove in Ein Hashofet Colony
